8. Committee Heads Reported out

a. Chaperone – [Devon] → List of interested individuals needs to be created. Requirements to become an approved Chaperone can be found on www.band.org and on the WWBPA FaceBook page. Frank noted that he received parent info forms for color guard and several parents are interested in chaperoning and volunteering → Their info will be forwarded to Devon.

We will be ordering chaperone shirts for anyone wanting a replacement or extra and also for new chaperones. Will announce price soon

b. **Hospitality – [Rhonda]** → {The Update was presented by <u>Frank DeNunzio</u>}

We have 4 home games and 1 parade at which food needs to be provided for the students. Since 1 game is the Chili Cook Off Night and 1 game is Senior Night, we should only need food for the other 2 home games and for the Honesdale Parade. Businesses will be contacted regarding food donations.

- c. **Publicity [Frank]** → Please make sure to fill out the forms regarding media/photos/videos to allow or not allow your child to be photographed.
- d. Color Guard Liaison → No Updates {Person who will be this year's Liaison will be decided during August}
- e. **Fundraising [Gina]** → Purse Bingo 15 regular games. All proceeds from the Purse Bingo will go into the Band Parent Account, to help offset the costs that chaperones pay to attend the annual Band/Color Guard Trip.
 - Looking into other fundraisers, such as Kernel Moonies Popcorn and freeze dried candy, Krispy Kreme Donuts {possibly during Hell Week}, Touch of Amish, Others TBA.
 - Will continue with the policy of "pick whichever fundraisers you want to participate in"
 - If any parents have any suggestions for fundraisers to consider, please reach out to Gina.
- f. Craft fair [Hope] → The Location Map for Vendor Spots, will be updated to include which areas will have access to electrical outlets so vendors needing access to outlets can be accommodated as best as possible. Have 54 of 139 slots paid as of mid-July.
 - The previous craft fair signs will be updated with new dates. Possibly handing them out to students in August during Hell Week.
 - This year student/family volunteers can get up to 12 hours of time credited into the student account. Will need to decide on the big door prize this year Discuss @ next meeting.
- **g.** Apparel tent [Kevin] → Inventory of items from last season has been redone. Contacting vendors for a new wholesale price list for this season to determine this year's retail pricing. General opinion is to steer more towards cold weather apparel.
- 9. **Directors Report** → [Mrs.Ort] → {unable to attend report presented by <u>Amanda Wilbur</u>} Band & Color Guard practices are starting, so no new updates yet.
- 10. New Business Trip Refunds → has been received from the tour company for the portion of the Virginia trip that was cancelled due to bad weather. Each student in attendance received a refund, which was credited back to their student accounts. The refunds for the chaperones were divided into remaining student accounts. Totals carry over into the 2025-26 season and will be posted.

Cavalcade \rightarrow We are hosting on Wed, October 1, 2025. Invited/participating schools will be announced. Will send out a letter requesting Raffle Baskets/or Items for baskets or gift cards/certificates or ask parents/students to reach out to businesses about donating. Working on the program guides for the Cavalcade \rightarrow Have not decided if we are running ads in the program, if so, the deadline will be 2nd or 3rd week of Sept. Need updated shirt sizes for current and new students. Devon brought up question on who decides design for cavalcade shirts and apparel \rightarrow Mrs.Ort and/or the students decide on the cavalcade and generally the band parents decide on any apparel graphics

Game Schedule \rightarrow has been updated \rightarrow The Dunmore game has now been changed to a Thursday night game. Phil and Frank will be posting the updated schedules on the Web and Facebook.

Band/Color Guard Camps → Donations of water and snacks are needed. Practices going on 3 days a week between Band and Color Guard. Frank will send out Remind msg, FB post and email. Gina reports that there are only 8 spare pairs of dinkels available. Will make up an order form for the students and report this year's cost at the next meeting. Summer/Relaxed Uniform

Shirt forms are going out to the kids. Sizes from XS to 6XL are \$15 – Order forms are due by August 15th to Mrs.Ort or Band Parents. Will be posting a copy of the form on FB and sending out a Remind App Msg.

- **11.Other Business** → Around July 28th, the power will be cut to the HS for 3 weeks, with an anticipation of power resuming before the first football game. Will have to get updates to know when we can start bringing all items back to the band and color guard closets.
- **12.**Board working on revised and updated bylaws to be presented at the August meeting. Will be posted on Website and FB.
