- 7. Old Business  $\rightarrow$ 
  - a. Cavalcade  $\rightarrow$  Hosting October 1st  $\rightarrow$  Need more volunteers to help, especially with concession stand and to serve the Bands  $\rightarrow$  Sign up to help on Sign Up Genius  $\rightarrow$  Link sent on Remind/Facebook/E-Mail  $\rightarrow$  Any adult can sign up  $\rightarrow$  Non-band students can also help with serving food
  - **b.** Cavalcade Food → Approx 640 Hot Dogs @\$104 → Utz donated 480 bags of chips → We have to travel to pickup → Herrs donated 10 cases of chips → ShopRite donated 45 packs of rolls → Haven't received response from Foxledge regarding water donations → We may have to purchase
  - **c.** Tents  $\rightarrow$  1 needed for apparel / baked goods & 1 for 50/50 andRaffle baskets

## 8. Committee Heads Report

- a. Chaperone Coordinator → [Devon] → Report given by Gina → Chaperones for cavalcade have been selected →list & position responsibilities will be texted → There will be 2 dedicated for the kids at all times and 1 backup. The rest will be divided out where they are needed → Everyone else should be signing up for positions on the sign up app.
- b. Hospitality Coordinator [Rhonda] → October 3rd is the annual Chilli Cookoff → we will not have food for the students. Students bring "pocket sandwiches"/food, if they prefer not to eat chili or bring cash for the concessions. For the lakeland game we will have pizza.
  - Parades → For the Honesdale parade, R-Place will be donating pasta, salad and chicken. Amanda requested that we purchase an extra tray of chicken → Rhonda will contact Gene to order it. We do not feed for the Barret Township parade.

- d. Color Guard Liaison → [Emma] Presented by Gina → Students had concerns over being segregated from the band. Becky said she will reach out and see if there is any viable solution to that issue.
- e. Fundraising Coordinator → [Gina] → Amish Dips → Sold 212 Dips → Should be available for pickup on Friday → we need about 70 copies of the Kernel Moonies fundraiser form printed → Frank will take care of that → Purse Bingo Pre-Sale coming up → Students get % of all tickets sold during pre-sale → Those tickets will be given out at the October 24th game → Hamlin Fire will be donating the bingo machine again → Cheesecake fundraiser → Possibly Monday Oct 27th start date → pickup will be around Thanksgiving → Dave & Buster Gift Cards before Xmas & Pickup @ concert → possibility of holding 2 bingos this school year → Proceeds would go towards off-setting the chaperones costs of the band trips → Will discuss at a future meeting
- f. Craft Fair Coordinators [Hope and Amanda] → Student Commitment Forms given to students, due back September 26th → No late submissions accepted! → 114 of 130 slots assigned and paid for → Email regarding setup times sent to vendors → Need student food vouchers printed → We have enough maps → Packets w/food menu, wifi and next years applications will be given to vendors
- g. Apparel Tent Coordinator [Kevin] → pre-order embroidered hoodies \$45
- h. Website Coordinator [Phil] → Cavalcade page is up with list of participating schools → will be live streamed & recorded → Senior pictures will be going up onto webpage
- i. Directors Report → [Mrs.Ort] → Report presented by Becky Rinella → 8th grade band night October 3rd → We are pre-game → Also Shriners award night → game start @7:10pm → Homecoming Night (Oct 3rd) students wear their Band/Guard shirts → Band @Penguins Game will be April 3rd → Great Adventure Trip will be Friday May 1st

## 9. New Business $\rightarrow$

- **a. Small Games of Chance License**  $\rightarrow$  approved  $\rightarrow$  We can sell 50/50 at games/events  $\rightarrow$  Need volunteers to man the 50/50 table  $\rightarrow$  if football starts selling 50/50, we will have to flip-flop selling the tickets
- b. Cavalcade Invites → We are having 10 schools at cavalcade → Becky emailed out invitations to the school board, cheerleaders, and football team, inviting them to our cavalcade and if they wear cheer/football apparel, they will be admitted for free. The band supports the football team and it would be nice if the football & cheer organization comes to show their support to the band as we do towards them.
- c. Cavalcade shirts → We pay \$12 retail for the shirts → \$7 from each shirt sold will go to the Band Parents account. Becky purchased all the materials for the shirts → Depending on how many are purchased, there is the potential of making \$1295 profit → Rhonda suggested that if we need more tents, we can borrow the ones from drama
- **d. Button Maker** → Can't locate it since it was last used → need it in order to make the buttons for cavalcade
- e. Senior Banners → Have been placed on display down at the stadium → Maintenance takes them down for us → Seniors will get their banner either before or at the Band Banquet

- f. Band Banquet We looked into several options and menu choices → Decided to keep event at Montdale Country Club as they are still giving us the best deal and amount of food choices → Date has been set for Sunday, May 17th → \$18 Adults / \$12 Children → Band/Color Guard Students are FREE
- **g. Senior Night** Previously gave SweatPants and/or Hoodies → Moving forward WWBPA will cover the cost of the Varsity Jackets → If you didn't get a jacket this year or already purchased, student will receive a gift card → Sashed have been ordered → **Rhonda** will get the flowers for parents..
- h. November Meeting District requested a date change due to parent teacher conferences → several date suggestions have been given by membership → Date will be decided at the October meeting
- i. Publicity Coordinator [Frank] → Not available for the homecoming game. Requesting that someone please take photos at homecoming, especially of any band alumni that play an instrument in the stands.
